## I. BENEFICIARIES

(a) Number and List of Beneficiaries:

**Number:** All 48 LDCs are eligible to become beneficiaries. However, so far 31 LDCs (Maldives and Samoa graduated) have become beneficiaries by providing a letter of intent as well as specimen seals and signatures of the officials authorised to issue the certificate of origin under the DFTP Scheme.

Beneficiaries are notified subject to submission of Letter of Intent, and details of signatories for issuing of certification of origin. Imports under preferential tariff allowed subject to fulfilling Rules of Origin.

There are three kinds of treatment namely: (i) Positive list of tariff lines with margin of preference specified against each tariff line; (ii) Duty Free lines which are duty free; and (iii) Exclusion list of tariff lines with no preferential treatment.
